65 years traffic historical gauge 1 model railway in Hamburg Museum

1949 2014

Opening of the exhibition on 7th October 2014 at 14:00 hrs

Under the motto "Full steam instead of pension" the Modellisenbahn Hamburg e.V. presented a new era of model railways. (MEHEV) celebrated its 65th anniversary at the end of August 2014 with a large model railway festival, which was very popular with an unusually high number of visitors.

On the current anniversary of the opening 65 years ago on 7th October 1949 in the Museum für Hamburgische Geschichte, the association opens an exhibition on the 2nd floor with models and Photographs from the early days of the layout. Below, you can see a compartment car, which was was made out of old schoolbooks after the war.

On 7th October 2014, the model railway demonstrations will not begin until 2 pm. The Cafe Fees is only open from 12:00.

It is planned to show the exhibition until the end of the year. Take the opportunity to visit this unique layout once again, as the operation and inventory in this form will end on the 2nd floor in the foreseeable future. The museum management would like to use the space for other purposes and wishes that the facility be dismantled and rebuilt elsewhere in the museum.

The opening hours of the Hamburg Museum are 10 am to 5 pm, Sundays to 6 pm. Admission: € 9.00 (reduced € 5.50) Children and young people under 18 free.
