THE MODEL RAILWAY LAYOUT SHOWS THE MODEL OF THE HAMBURG-HARBURG STATION AND THE MAIN FREIGHT STATION HAMBURG

As if at the real train station, the trains roll over the extensive railway network. During an intercity train shortly stops at the platform, a local train rolls in, freight trains drive through the station, locomotives pass by an interlocking building on the way to the locomotive shed in the Rail depot. Signals change their display, in the distance the top light of another train appears.

From one location it is possible to operate the entire to overlook the huge train station. Suddenly the the tangle of train journeys to an orderly sequence, controlled by switches and signals.

"Please board the train..."

The original models of the railway station Hamburg-Harburg, the main freight station Hamburg, the former pillar railway and one of the typical Hamburg quayside shed with its Railway siding to the port railway, as it was before construction of the new harbor city. On the site, the steam locomotive their once predominant position still not sold, but also diesel locomotives, railcars and electric locomotives are shown in operation.

The construction of the model railway site began in 1947 on behalf of the museum by the members and friends of model railway Hamburg e.V. (MEHEV) built and is still supervised and demonstrated by them today.

SELF DRIVES?

Interested visitors are welcome during the demonstration breaks to drive under instruction trains at the interlockings themselves.

There is a playground for children in the Size H0 available.

- Many vehicles are self-built unique specimens.
- Since its opening on 7 October 1949, the Model railway system in about 65.000 demonstrations over 2,2 millions of visitors.
- The vehicles that are used on a regular basis about 150 km per year.
- All signals fulfil their function as with the big original.
- The pillar railway is with us still in her old Design in operation.



TECHNICAL DETAILS

- Size 1, scale 1:32, gauge 45 mm
- Model railway system size 250 m²
- Track length 1200 m, 240 switches, 144 signals, including 22 form signals,
- approx. 40.000 m cables, driving voltage 24 V
- Control according to the Gahler & Ringstmeyer system, with a route specification for the trains whose locations can be updated by the computer,
- Operating variants via PC, push-button interlocking and by screen interlockings
- more than 100 locomotives (steam locomotives, diesel locomotives, electric locomotives, railcars, small locomotives and an ICE)
