The model railway layout of the association "Modelleisenbahn Hamburg e.V." (MEHEV) at Holstenwall has been a magnet for visitors to Hamburg since 1949 and is a unique attraction at a scale of 1:32. With an area of 250 square metres and a track length of 1200 metres, it is Hamburg's largest layout on a scale of 1:32. Everyday rail life between Hamburg's main railway station and Harburg is depicted very closely - with passenger, freight and marshalling yards, port operations and railway depot. As with the large model, up to 70 different locomotives, railcars and small locomotives with around 400 wagons can be admired.
